### **Health & Safety Requirements**

- All exhibitors must be on site and set up / running by 0945 hours on show days – strictly no entry to the site after this time.
- All non – display vehicles to leave the show site by 0930 hrs on show days
- Shut down for exhibits is 1600 hrs on Sunday
- No vehicle movement on or off of the site before 1800 hrs Saturday and 1600 hrs on the Sunday
- Any problems / complaints / disputes will be dealt with by the Directors and the Health and Safety Officer – their decision is final.
- All catering units to ensure they have an in date and working fire extinguisher available
- All catering units to remove cooking oil and excess rubbish when leaving the site

### **DECLARATION**

In consideration of the acceptance of my entry and of my being permitted to take part in the above named show, I declare that during the whole period of the show my entry will be covered by a Public Liability Insurance policy (including Rally use) having a limit of indemnity of not less than £2,000,000 for any one accident. Please check with your present insurers, you may already be covered. I confirm that the driver/s of any vehicles entered in the Show hold/s a valid licence to drive a vehicle of the appropriate class.

### **Electric**

The IEE Regulations requires that a 16A connection is the only acceptable means of connecting to a CBC external power supply. 13A connections alone, or by use of a 13A/16A adaptor are not acceptable and will not be connected to the Show's power supply. It is your responsibility to provide a 16A 'male' socket in order to connect to the Show's supply; it is a requirement that the cable used by you shall be less than 2.5mm<sup>2</sup> duty cable.

- 16A supplies are available, however, these are not to be exceeded in one single feed from the supply
- 1 item of electrical equipment will require one 16A connection and feed. More than 1 item of equipment to be connected must be supplied by a 16A multi-gang. You are solely responsible for all wiring and equipment within your stall up to the Show's side of the 16A supply connection
- All electrical equipment to be used by the trader must display a current and valid Portable Appliance Test Certificate
- No connection will be made to the Show's power supply unless the inspection electrician is satisfied the above requirements have been met
- Should there be an unexpected long-term loss of power due to an unforeseen event it is recommended that you have your own insurance to cover any losses as a result of the power failure.

**I/We hereby agree to abide by the requirements for an electrical supply as set out above and acknowledge that failure by me/us may result in the power supply being restricted, disconnected or not provided.**
