PUBLIC CAMPING BOOKING FORM

General Information

please read carefully before booking:

- Please note there is no electric hook up on site
- Fresh water, elsan disposal point, rubbish bins and toilets are provided
- Overnight security will be in place on Friday and Saturday all night
- All pitches are on grass and sloping
- **No glass bottles or drinking vessels are allowed within the showground. Bag searches will be carried out by official security when entering the show from the public camping area**
- **BBQ's** – All BBQ's (gas or disposable) must be on a raised platform with at least 300mm clearance from the ground due to fire risk. Mobile security staff will monitor the use of BBQ's, if in doubt please ask! Please consider the wind direction, smoke from your BBQ may affect fellow campers!
- No generators between the times of 9.00pm and 9.00am. Consider other campers.
- Please keep noise on the campsite to a minimum and respect other campers. Noise deemed excessive by the show organisers will not be tolerated and may result in you being asked to leave the site
- Dogs are welcome but must be kept on leads at all times, please clear up dog mess. A failure to do so may result in you being asked to leave the site
- Wristbands will be provided for weekend camping and must be worn at all times. You will not be able to enter the show site without these.
- Any problems / complaints / disputes must be reported to the show office adjacent to the main arena. All complaints will be dealt with by the Directors and the Health and Safety Officer, their decision is final.
- Chickerell Steam & Vintage Show accepts no liability for any loss, damage or injury caused whilst on site.

Please set up your unit as per instructions by the public camping stewards. Mandatory fire spacing regulations are applied for everyone's health and wellbeing and need to be adhered to at all times. The decision of the steward is final.

Arrivals to the public camping area can access the site between 9.00am to 8.30pm Friday or Saturday. All campers must be clear of the site by 10.00am Monday 8th July 2019.

If you wish to camp together as a group, please let us know in advance in order that the camping stewards are aware, they will do their utmost to accommodate you as far as possible.

MAXIMUM SHOW SITE SPEED LIMIT IN FORCE OF 5MPH. PLEASE RESPECT THE SPEED ON SITE.

Pitch Sizes and Fees

Each pitch will be 8m x 7m

This allows for either

- 1 tent and 1 vehicle (car/small van)
- 1 caravan and awning, 1 vehicle (car/small van)
- 1 motorhome – size must be stated

Any unit with a second vehicle will be asked to park in the car park.

If your unit is larger than the pitch size of 8m x 7m, please contact Samantha Spracklen (details below). This may result in a slightly higher pitch charge.

Any units over and above the pitch area will be subject to an increased fee or be refused access by security staff.

£36 per pitch for up to three nights (Friday, Saturday, Sunday nights).

You will be supplied with a camping pass for your vehicle which must be displayed in the windscreen on arrival.

Show Entry Fees

Weekend entry ticket

£14 per adult, £5 per child (aged 5 to 16), under 5's are free

Wristbands will be provided which must be worn at all times

Weekend Family ticket – £35

This provides entry for 2 adults and up to 3 children

For those camping for the weekend, free entry is included on Friday evening where there will be entertainment and bar available. Wristbands must be worn.
